

Questions to Expect on your interview:

- How would you describe yourself?
- Why should I hire you?
- What do you know about our company/organization?
- Why do you want to work for us?
- Tell me about your last job?
- What did you like most and what did you like least about that job?
- Tell me about your education and training?
- Are you involved in after school activities?
- Do you plan to continue your education after high school?
- Give an example of any major problem you have faced and how you solved it?
- What is your greatest weakness?
- What is your greatest strength?

Questions to ask during your interview?

You will be expected to ask well thought out questions. Don't be afraid to pull out a sheet of questions to ask. Managers are usually impressed with applicants who prepare.

Don't ask questions about salary. Wait for the manager to bring up wages. They usually do.

- Could you describe a typical workday and what would I be doing if hired?
- How would I be trained for this job?
- Can you tell me about the company and how my position contributes to the organization?
- Would I be working by myself or with others?
- What are the hours required?
